Entertainers/Special Visitors to school

Parents may be asked to make a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the events.

Every year we have Jo Jingles and other outside visitors who come into Nursery to work with the children. These are extra activities we purchase to encourage the children to enjoy learning whilst developing their listening, communication and all around development.

Snack Money

Parents are requested to make a voluntary contribution of £1 per week for snack money. We feel this is of great benefit to the children as children who have eaten a snack of fruit during the nursery session are more likely to develop their concentration and listening skills and therefore make rapid progress within all areas of the curriculum.

School Trips

We do not organise school trips. Every attempt is made to provide a range of opportunities for the children to experience within the nursery.

School Fund and Non-Uniform day's

Every half term we will be holding a non-uniform day and asking the parents for a voluntary contribution of £1 to go to 'School Fund'. These contributions are used to purchase various items and activities for the children e.g. birthday presents, Christmas presents, bottled water for the classrooms.
