Nursery School Attendance

In order for the children to benefit from their Nursery education children need to attend regularly and be on time. We expect your child will attend for every session and turn up on time. In the morning children should arrive for 9:00am and in the afternoon for 12:45pm. We need to aim for 85% attendance this term.

A few children are missing Nursery due to colds and runny noses at the moment. Children should only miss nursery for real illnesses or doctors / hospital appointments, not really for coughs and colds. If your child is going to miss their session please ring Nursery on 01254 231725 and inform us straight away. Thank you

Friday 19th October - non-uniform day

Children are invited to come to nursery in their own clothes, (but must still come with a suitable coat to play outside). A £1 donation to school funds will be collected on that day.

Wednesday 31st October - Photo Day

The photographer will be in nursery today to take individual photos of the children in their own clothes. No appointments necessary, staff take the children in to have photos taken.

Half-term - week beginning **22nd Oct** and we will be open again on Monday 29th October.

Thursday 8th November - Family Toy Appeal Day - Save the date

We are holding a family fun day on the 8th November where parents/grandparents/carers are invited to come to Nursery to take part in fun activities and play games together. We are asking families to donate new toys on the day which we are collecting to give to a local charity to give disadvantaged children presents at Christmas.

Mobile Phones

Please could we remind parents and carers that the use of mobile phones is **not** permitted in the classrooms, due to safeguarding reasons.

Nursery Fund - A reminder

We collect contributions of £2 a week to Nursery school fund in each classroom. This contribution goes towards buying extra things for the children that we couldn't afford to do regularly, such as baking, snack days, visitors, parties etc. If all the 3/4 year old children brought their £2 a week it would give us an extra £150 a week to spend on the children.

Outdoor clothing
