Nursery School Attendance

In order for the children to benefit from their Nursery education children need to attend regularly and be on time. We expect your child will attend for every session and turn up on time. In the **morning children** should arrive for **9:00am** and in the **afternoon** for **12:45pm**. We need to aim for 85% and higher attendance for this term.

Some children are missing Nursery due to coughs, colds and runny noses, this is a normal part of school life. Children should only miss nursery for real illnesses or doctors / hospital appointments, not really for coughs and colds.
